

THE SUBURB, appropriately known as Hill City, is situated on the picturesque ground north of Chattanooga.

A few years since two or three hundred people constituted the population of this suburb, with only a house here and there. Now there is a population of 2,700; four schools; five churches; two electric car lines; a number of secret societies, and over 600 houses.

Hill City is ideally located for health—high, pure air from the mountains, a natural drainage to the river.

From this place there stretches all around a panorama of rare beauty and grandeur. A picture of hill and valley and mountain, and between, the broad sweep of the river. A scene unsurpassed in any country—inspiring, elevating.


On the commanding hills of this section, during the great conflict of half a century ago, tents were pitched and forts erected; while from Market street to Ferry street, the Federals constructed a wooden bridge. This bridge was swept away by the flood of 1867. All that now remains is a solitary pier to mark the place where it once stood.


Up to the time of the completion of the new bridge, at Walnut street, people were transported across the river by means of horse, swing and steam ferries. The swing ferry was operated by means of a wire cable, fastened on the island lying between Chattanooga and Hill City.

The present bridge was commenced in 1889 and completed in 1891 at a cost of \$233,697. Twenty-five thousand dollars of this sum was given by certain citizens of Hill City. This bridge spans the river from Walnut street, Chattanooga, to Forest avenue, Hill City, and is one of the finest structures of its kind in the South.

Along educational lines, Hill City has kept apace with her commercial enterprise. The Chattanooga Normal University is situated on a commanding eminence overlooking the city. This building was erected in 1896 at a cost of \$25,000. The school is now ably conducted by Prof. Samuel Hixson and a faculty of efficient associates.

It requires no prophet's eye to read the future of this splendid suburb—in distance the nearest to Chattanooga. The vast mineral and timber resources of Waldens Ridge will in the near future bring a railroad bridge. Then, of course, the railroad follows, penetrating the heart of this undeveloped section and conveying its wealth into the channels of trade. Manufacturing plants of every character, now only waiting for transportation facilities, will be erected along the line of road and river front. The potent powers of the suck will be utilized to bring water, light and other necessary utilities. Then Hill City will lead her sister suburbs as far commercially as she now distances them in the beauty of her natural scenery.




The Bridge, from Hill City, Lookaut Mountain in the background.






